



## Final draft of Delta Plan, other documents made available by DSC

The Delta Stewardship Council (DSC) has released the [final draft of the Delta Plan](#). At the same time, the DSC has also released a [Recirculated Draft Delta Plan Programmatic Environmental Impact Report](#) and [draft regulations](#) based on policies in the Delta Plan's final draft. The California Natural Resources Agency has published a fact sheet highlighting the differences between the Bay Delta Conservation Plan (BDCP) and the 1982 Peripheral Canal proposal. [BDCP: A 21st Century Strategy](#) breaks the BDCP project into pieces and explains how different this new plan to protect the water supply and restore the Delta ecosystem is compared with the canal proposal.

## Delta Conservancy subcommittee set to meet next week

The Program and Policy Subcommittee of the [Delta Conservancy Board](#) will be meeting next week in West Sacramento. The [agenda](#) for Wednesday, Dec. 12, includes a review of the subcommittee's draft charter and a draft copy of the conservancy's implementation plan. There will also be a legislative update by the chief consultant of the State Assembly's Select Committee on Regional Approaches to Addressing the State's Water Crisis.

## Draft report on flood future looks at risks and recommendations

A new draft of [California's Flood Future Highlights](#) has been posted on the DWR website. It is a collaborative effort between DWR and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to provide a look at statewide flood risk, along with recommendations for improving and financing integrated flood management.
