GSP Issue Topics for Regulation Development



The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act requires the formation of Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs) which must develop GSPs in the Bulletin 118-defined groundwater basins or subbasins that were designated by DWR as medium or high priority. DWR has established a comprehensive multi-phased outreach approach to better understand issues and topics and to collect information associated with the development of GSP regulations. Insights gained through the outreach process will build an informed regulation framework.
