Congratulations to you and your staff for all your hard work! Attached is a digital copy of the official letter. You may have already received a signed original in the mail.

The next step will be to upload your groundwater elevation level data into the CASGEM Online System beginning with data starting in Fall, 2011. With the ongoing drought conditions persisting throughout the state, DWR has been encouraging all monitoring entities to consider uploading any additional available historical data for their CASGEM well network to the CASGEM Online System (OS). This would be any available data preceding the Fall, 2011 requirement in the SBX7-6 legislation. This is not a mandatory requirement but rather a proactive request as we continue to make efforts to analyze the seasonal high and low groundwater elevation level trends throughout the years.
