- 3/** Does not include 1.14 cfs continuous and 0.12 surplus (1.26 cfs total) transferred to Tract 2.
- 4/** Tract 2 includes 1.14 cfs continuous and 0.12 cfs surplus (1.26 cfs total) transferred from Tract 7-2. The transferred water is split proportionally by decreed acreage as with the original rights.
- 5/** Tract 10 is also entitled to divert 0.75 cfs from Canyon Creek and entire flow of Spring Creek. See paragraphs 1 and 2, Decree # 5111. These rights are not included in watermaster billing.
- 6/** Tract 12 was switched to direct billing (USA - Indian) following an inquiry from Shasta Co. assessor regarding a delinquent tax bill. This Tract is confirmed to be Indian land. Therefore the property is not billed.
- 7/** The lands of Ednah Black may divert water delivered through the Greer-Cornaz Ditch and then returned to Burney Creek at the end of the ditch, then pumped out at Diversion # 5.5; or may divert water left in Burney Creek and pumped out at Diversion # 5.5 while creek flows are over 100 percent of rights.
- 8/** Greer, Fred lands in the 1926 decree were replaced by the lands of Cook, Howell & Estes, G. C. in the 1948 decree.

Notes:

1/ Decree # 5111 allocated water rights from Burney Creek on a rotation basis. Since the decree was finalized in 1926, the water right owners have requested to divert on a continuous flow basis. The continuous flow allotments plus surplus allotments are also used for watermaster billing purposes.

2/ Per Schedule I, Decree # 5111.

3/ Per Schedule II, Decree # 5111. Schedule II total states 25.30 cfs, but sum of allotments equals 25.35.

4/ Per paragraphs 8 and 10, Decree # 5111. These minimum flows were intended for domestic and stockwater purposes and were decreed to particular ditches and not owners during off-rotation periods. These minimums were assigned to particular Tracts to determine continuous flow allotments.
