ORDER EXPANDING MIDDLE FORK FEATHER RIVER WATERMASTER SERVICE
AREA
SIERRA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
AND
DESCRIPTION OF ADDITIONAL LANDS WITHIN SAID SERVICE AREA
AS SO CREATED

WHEREAS Section 4026 of the California Water Code authorizes creation of watermaster service areas as rights to water are ascertained and determined; and

WHEREAS the rights of various claimants and permittees to the use of water of the Middle Fork Feather River was established by Plumas County Superior Court Decree Number 3095, dated January 19, 1940;

WHEREAS the most practical and economical supervision of the distribution of the waters of Lemon Canyon Creek on the part of the State may be accomplished by the expansion of the watermaster service area to cover this additional territory as is now pertinent to said water rights, as defined in said Decree,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Middle Fork Feather River Watermaster Service Area be expanded, as provided in Water Code sections 4025 through 4032, Division 2, Part 4, Chapter 2, of the State of California Water Code, said watermaster service area shall be expanded to include those lands described in Exhibit A, "Middle Fork Feather River Watermaster Service Area, Public Land Survey System Designation Of Expanded Area" appended hereto and made a part hereof.


